5. When you get to the Jeffco Connect page click on the button that states, "Jeffco Connect Student Information Login"
6. Log in using the same username and password information you use to login to Schoology and Infinite Campus (if you need a password reset contact the front office of either campus)
7. In the left hand column click on "Jeffco Student Fee Payment"
8. Select your student or students and click the green arrow to continue
9. Make your fee payment

1. Students will need a free College Board account to view their scores online.
2. Direct students to <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/viewscore> to sign-up for a new account or log in to their existing account.
3. The "forgot username" and "forgot password" links can be used to recover this information if a student has forgotten their login credentials or if they are unsure if they already have an account.

Please note: Although most scores will be released according to the schedule above, some scores will be released later for reasons that may include participation in the accommodated testing window, makeup testing, late receipt of answer sheets, missing information on the answer sheet, or other exceptional conditions that require additional attention. Please use the appropriate grade level link below to sign-up for courses for the 2018-2019 school year. The link will remain open until Friday, April 27th.

Please keep in mind:

- Please select a first and a second option. We do our best to give you either your first or second choice each class period.
- Kindergarten and First Grade will choose their first choice of day of the week. There are no individual courses to select as both classes are self-contained.
- Elementary must select at least 6 courses.
- Secondary must select at least 3 courses.
- Secondary students must be enrolled in a class to be on campus. Students not enrolled in a class, may not 'hang out' on campus.
- Study halls MAY be offered 2nd - 5th period for Secondary students if we have enough students. We recognize that as homeschoolers, your students have other days throughout the week to complete their homework, college courses, homeschool courses, online, etc. Use the comment section to indicate a study hall request.
- Schedules will be created over the next few weeks in order they are received. If you make changes to your original submission, your new submission will be time stamped accordingly.
- As a reminder, families who still have unpaid fees will drop in priority until fees have been paid. Families who have yet to fulfill parent volunteer hours, will also drop in priority. Families who have completed 20+ hours and are signed-up to fulfill their 25 hours will be keep their priority as timestamped. Please stop by the front desk if you need assistance with either fees or parent volunteer hours.
